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## **PRECURSORS OF DISTANCE TEACHING OF DESCRIPTIVE GEOMETRY.**

Idea of distance teaching has a long story. At the beginning of XVIII century in United States was show advertisement about correspondence teaching. In 1948 there was five institutions which leads television courses. In Poland the first one which tries to teach for interval was Jagiellonian University. In 1776. they begin professional correspondence courses for craftsmen. In years 1966-1971 in Poland was acting television technical university, where was provided descriptive geometry lectures too.

The lectures were prepared very precisely and were leaded mainly by prof. F Otto and dr inż. Z. Dzięgielewski in Gdansk's television studio. Participation in preparation and realization of this program had also msc. T. Kobzdej and dr E. Korczak (lecture about axonometric). The lectures was designed for first term technical study for beginners. Firstly its were shown on live, but last year some of them was registered on TV tape.
